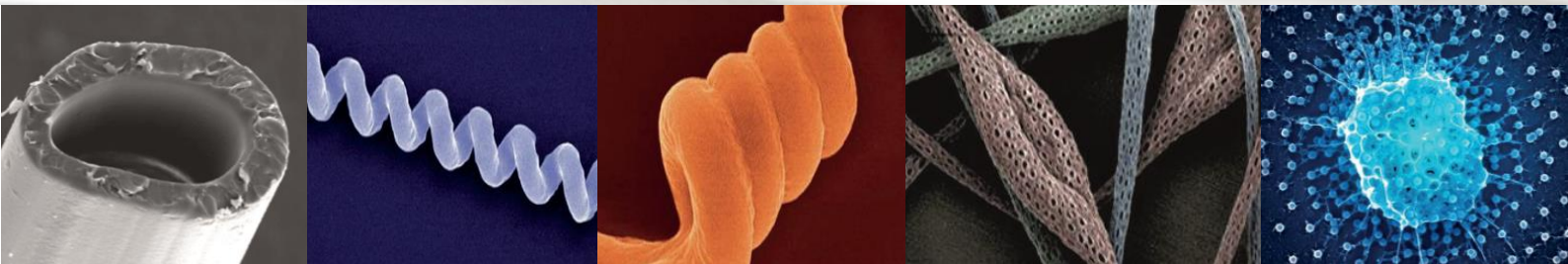

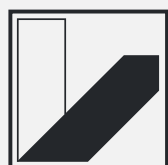

17th Bayreuth Polymer Symposium

BPS '21 is the 17th biennial international Bayreuth Polymer Symposium. Current topics of interest from research areas will be presented including *functional polymers, polymer materials, polymer colloids, polymer interfaces, polymer nanostructures, polymer nanotechnology, and biomaterials*.

A primary objective of this meeting is to bring people together from different areas of polymer, colloid and materials science to discuss different aspects of fundamental and applied research.

The symposium will be held this year in an online format.

SCIENTIFIC PROGRAM

The scientific program consists of *invited lectures* (25 minutes) and a *poster session* with a two minute oral introduction.

The conference language is English.
